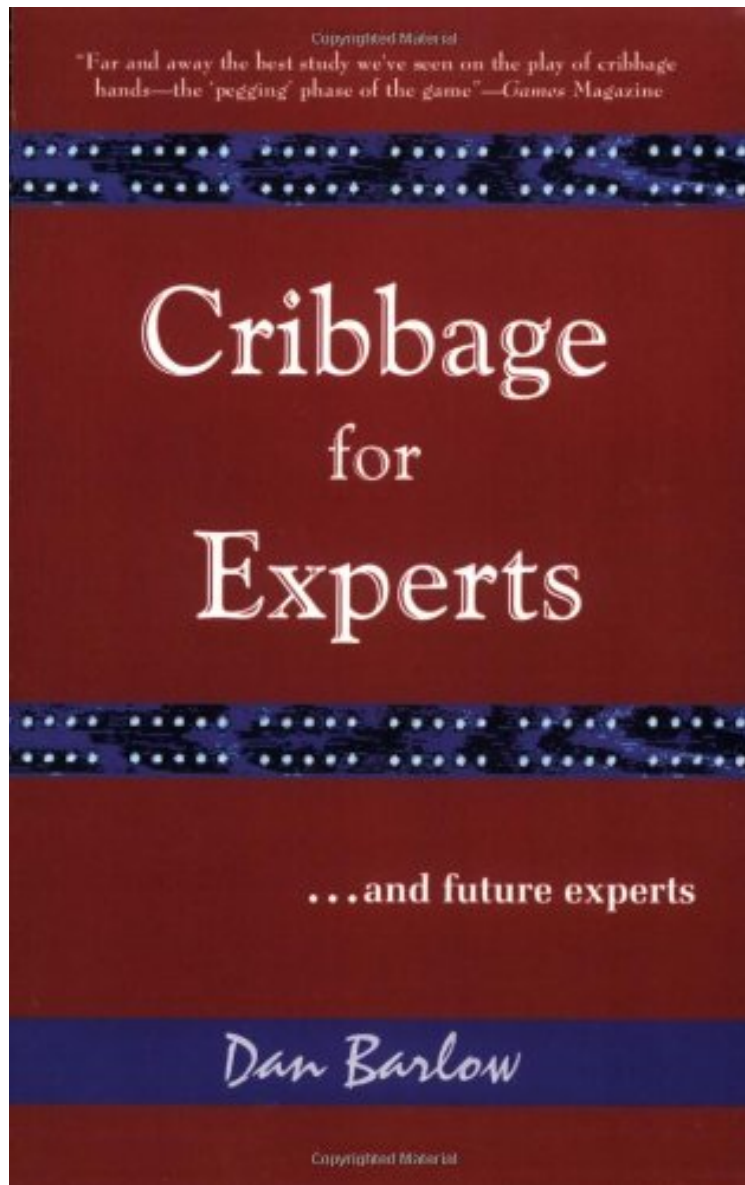

Both titles include a hefty dose of Barlow's cribbage strength, which is end-game evaluation. *Cribbage for Experts*, with a little bit wider focus and a bit more accessible of a format, is probably the second or third cribbage book players should acquire, DeLynn Colvert's *Play Winning Cribbage* still being the best.
