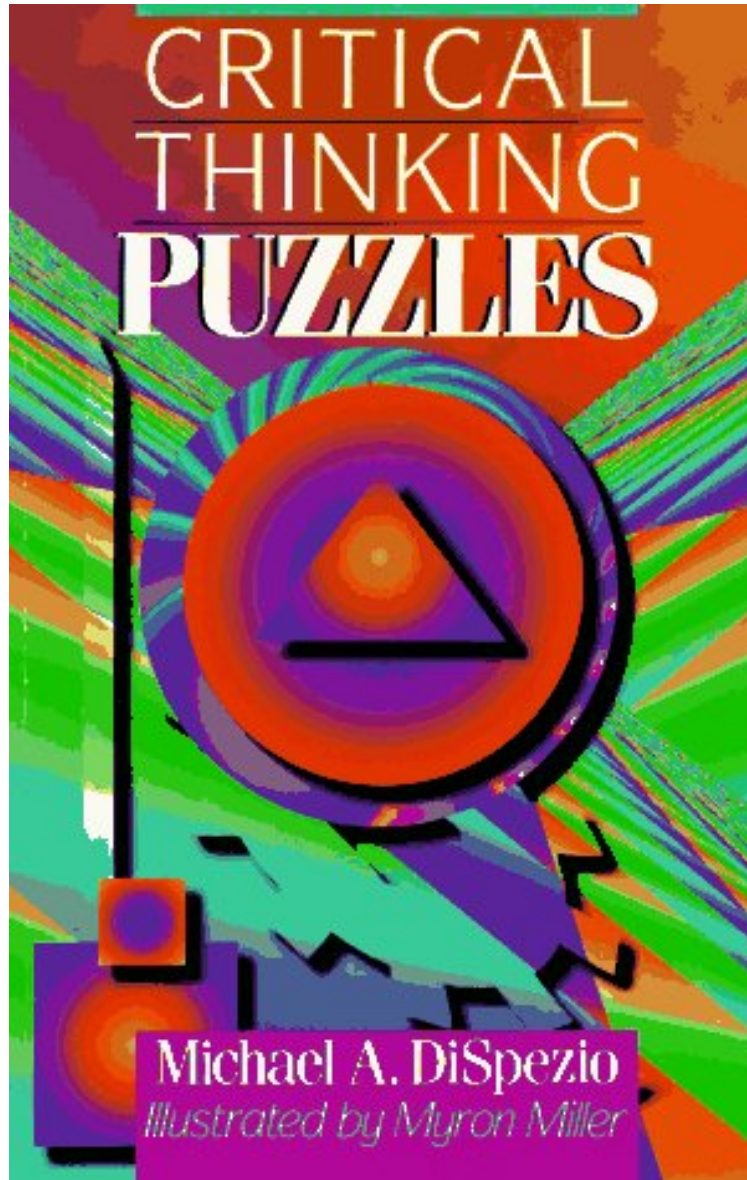

They publish books of various sizes, but this one is 5 1/4" x 8 1/4" and about 100

pages. They have a large selection of books of this size. They are authored by several of the most popular puzzle creators. The quality of the paper, printing and cover are excellent. This book of Critical Thinking puzzles is an excellent collection of puzzles, some as old as the hills, some adaptations of common posers, and some new, probably by the author. Other Reviewers have suggested they are maybe too simple, but I disagree. I have been a puzzle addict (a metagrobologist) for about 70 years and have a huge collection of puzzle books. While some of these puzzles are quite simple, there are plenty of others that will entertain and challenge novices as well as others with more experience. It is a great little book for introducing people of all ages to the intriguing and diabolical world of puzzles. There is a bit of everything from matchstick puzzles, magic squares, dissection puzzles, passage puzzles, magic tricks, tagrams, balance puzzles, pattern puzzles, Mobius Strips, measuring puzzles, impossible figures; you name it, they're all here. For every type of puzzle you'll find here, there are lots of books filled with that type of puzzle; ie. Tangrams, Magic Squares, Matchsticks, etc. 5 of 9 people found the following review helpful.
