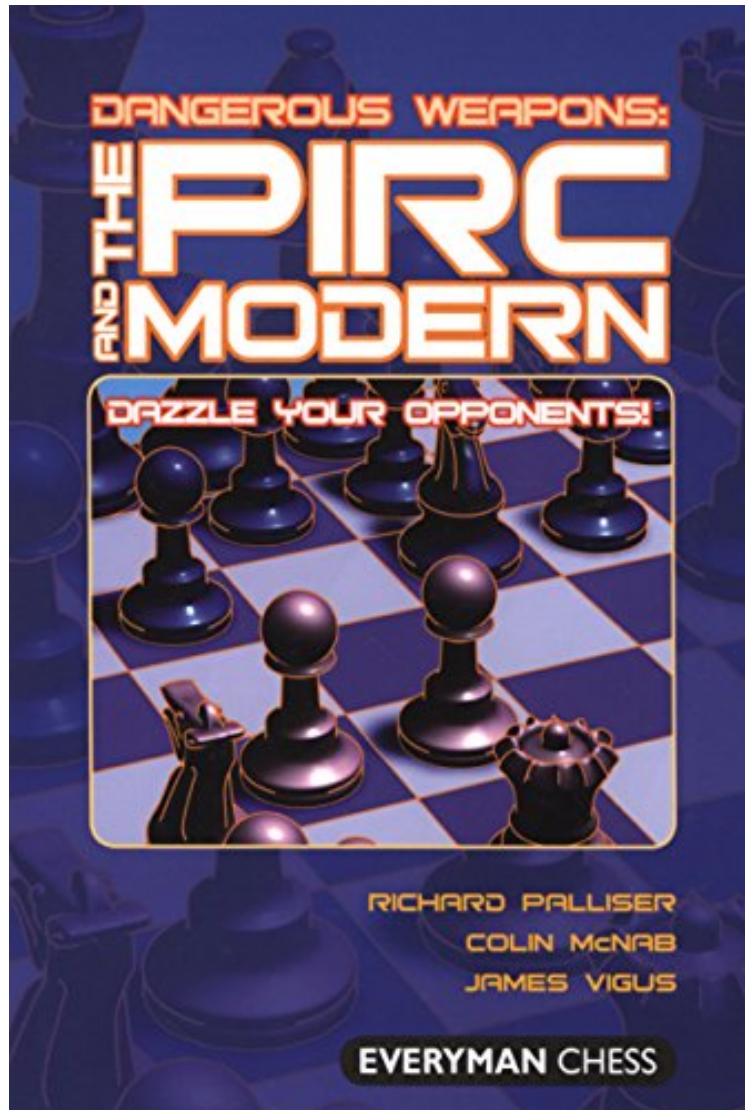

Among other things are the delayed Austrian Attack, the delayed Spike and the delayed "150" Attack which will definitely put black on his toes, and for black are a number of early deviations to sidestep white mainlines and put white on his toes. Written by such Pirc-Modern specialists as James Vigus, Colin McNab, and Richard Palliser, this book is a must for the serious chess player regardless of strength.
