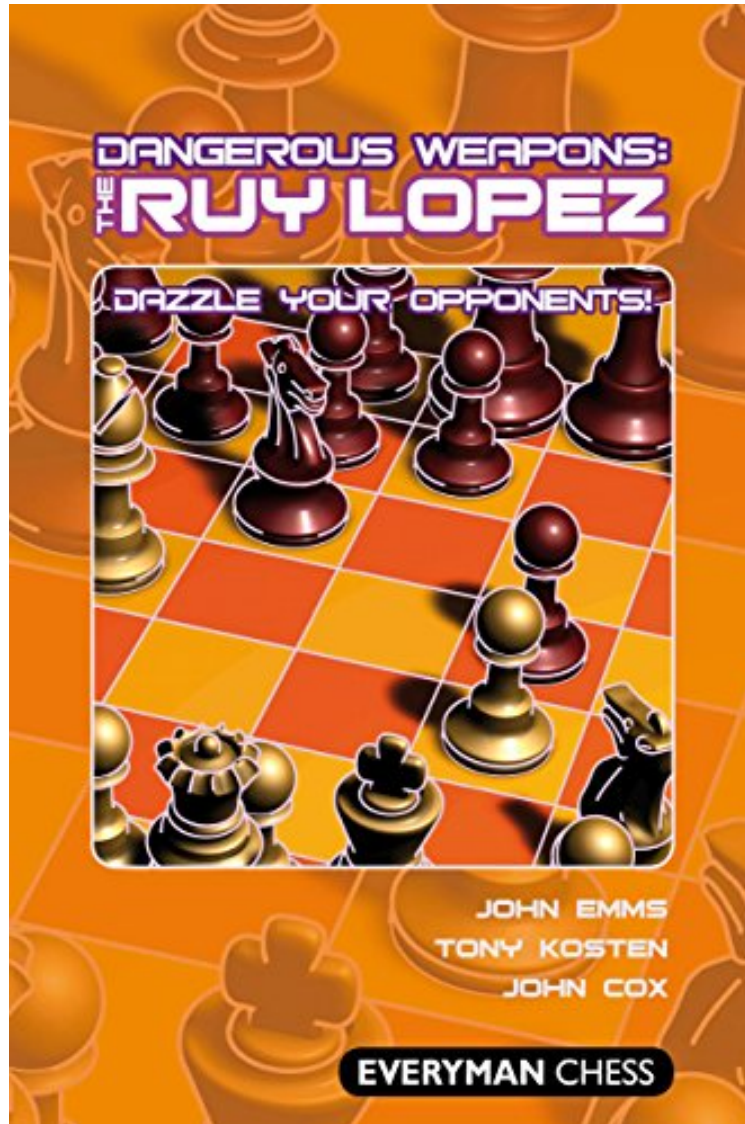

Moreover, this book has a very harsh printing smell all over, and the printing paper are clearly cheap and darker than any of the Everyman chess book I've bought (so far I own over 40 Everyman books).
