Being an avid Dark Souls fan, I have purchased every collector's item for the franchise since the first Dark Souls Collector's Guide came out. It was beautifully put together with fantastic artwork and up to date (before the many patches that followed over the years) information. And as a guide I would rate this product at 4-5 stars by itself and definitely as a 5 star rating with the included journal (which is included in the standard non-flask edition guide). But this product fails because of the primary reason people bought it: the included Estus flask replica. Yes, I know that Prima announced early on that you wouldn't be able to drink from the flask because it was a solid piece. I still bought this product because even without being able to drink from it, if the flask came as pictured then it would still be worth the discounted (\$78 when I purchased it) price to me. Only problem is that Prima failed once again by packaging a flask that feels and looks cheap. A fairly obvious seam can be seen on the side, the colors are bland with a singular tone of green versus the design in the picture, and the entire piece isn't even to size compared to the in game model. The only retribution that can come from this product, and the reason I was tempted to give it two stars, is the bookmark. It is well designed and pretty well detailed for its size, but even that has its drawbacks. It is in a weird between point of not being sharp enough to be a letter opener (which would have been a better choice than a bookmark in my opinion) and being too thick to make a practical bookmark. Overall I am very disappointed in this product which was already losing ground and viability from day one. Prima really dropped the ball on this great opportunity.
