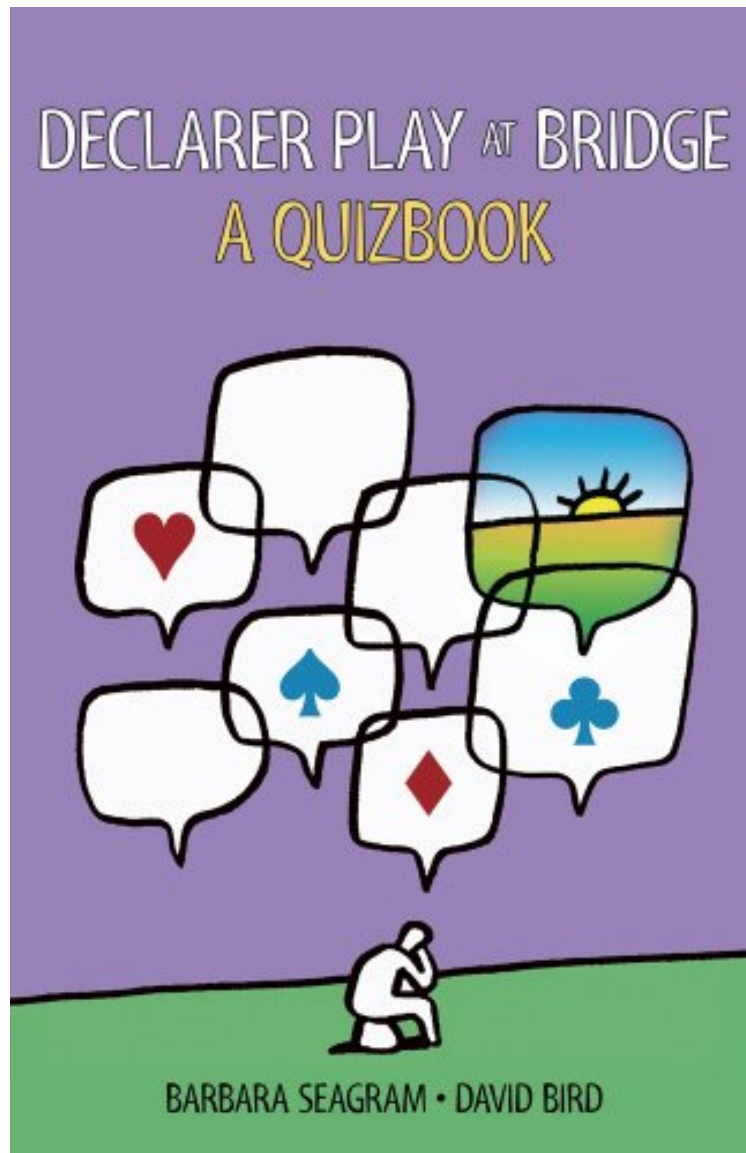

I think anyone who has played duplicate bridge seriously would find the book too introductory. It's a useful lead-up to Dorothy Hayden's "Winning Declarer Play".

This title gives near-beginners at bridge a chance to practice the principles on which sound declarer play is based: count your winners, count your losers, make a plan. This is not just a series of problem hands, however. Each section contains a brief introduction of its topic, and the ideas are reinforced with carefully explained solutions and helpful tips throughout.
