The puzzle grids range in size from 13 by 13 all the way to 23 by 23. These new and different puzzles will challenge your spatial and logical reasoning while providing hours of puzzle-solving fun. With their lack of planned-word arrangement, they will engage puzzle solvers on a whole new level.
