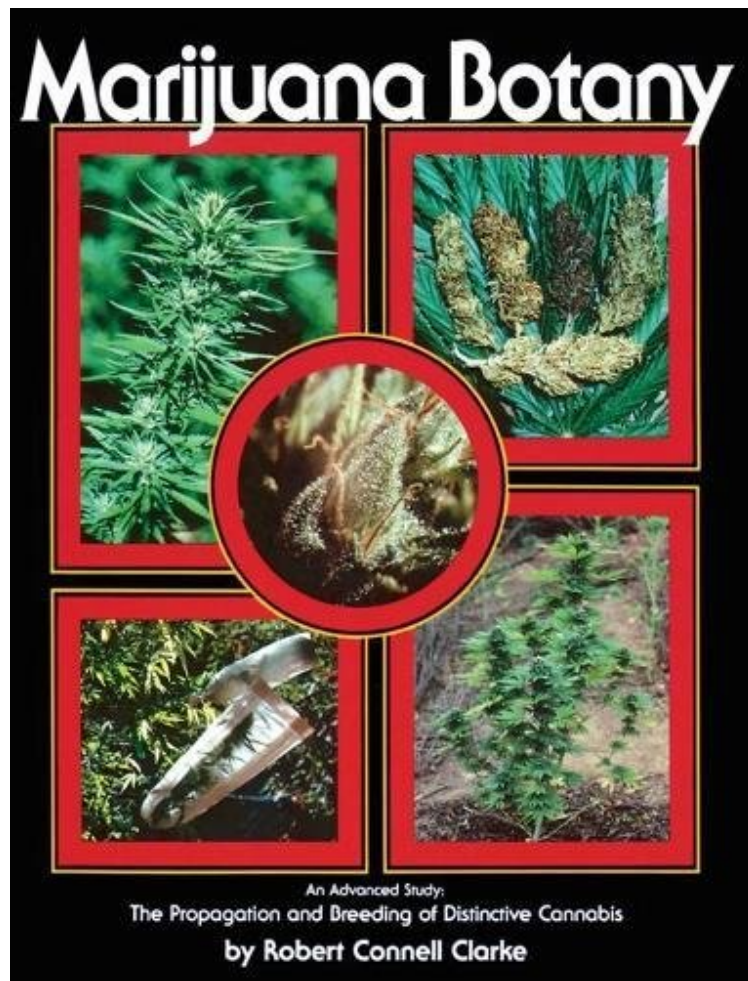

It is not the best book if you are looking for general information on how to grow marijuana--although cloning techniques like air-layering are covered well. The main benefit of this book is the detailed description of how to selective fertilize plants for seed propagation. It shows, for example, how to use bags to fertilize some of your female flowers while leaving others unfertilized.If you

are interested in developing seed this is a must read. If you just want to grow feminized seed and clones you probably don't need this book.
