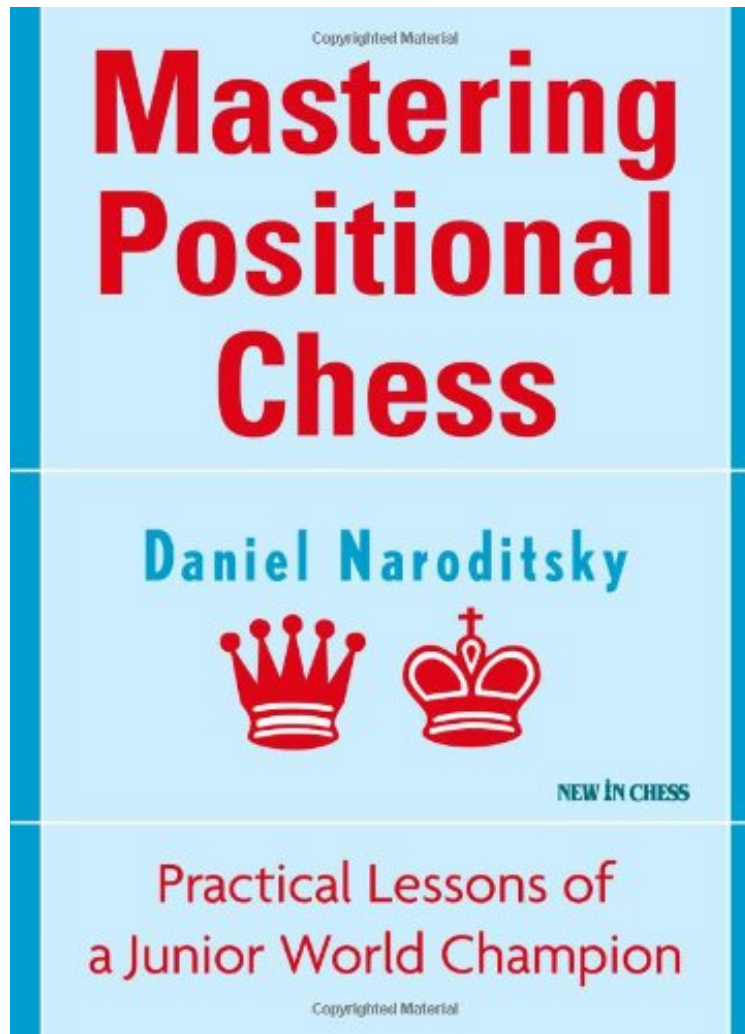

Great themes and explanationsBy ldaveMastering Positional Chess covers several important themes that I have found not to be covered a lot elsewhere including fortresses, positional sacrifice, and prophylaxis. I liked the detailed verbal explanations of the games presented. The explanations clarified the

thinking of the player and why one would sacrifice a pawn for position or be able to create a good fortress when down a lot of material. There are also interesting exercises to do at the end of each chapter. Having these problems to do makes the book feel like a mini-course, which is great for learning. I was a little disappointed that there was not much more on his games. I was hoping to see more of his insights and approach to chess rather than a lot of games of other players.
