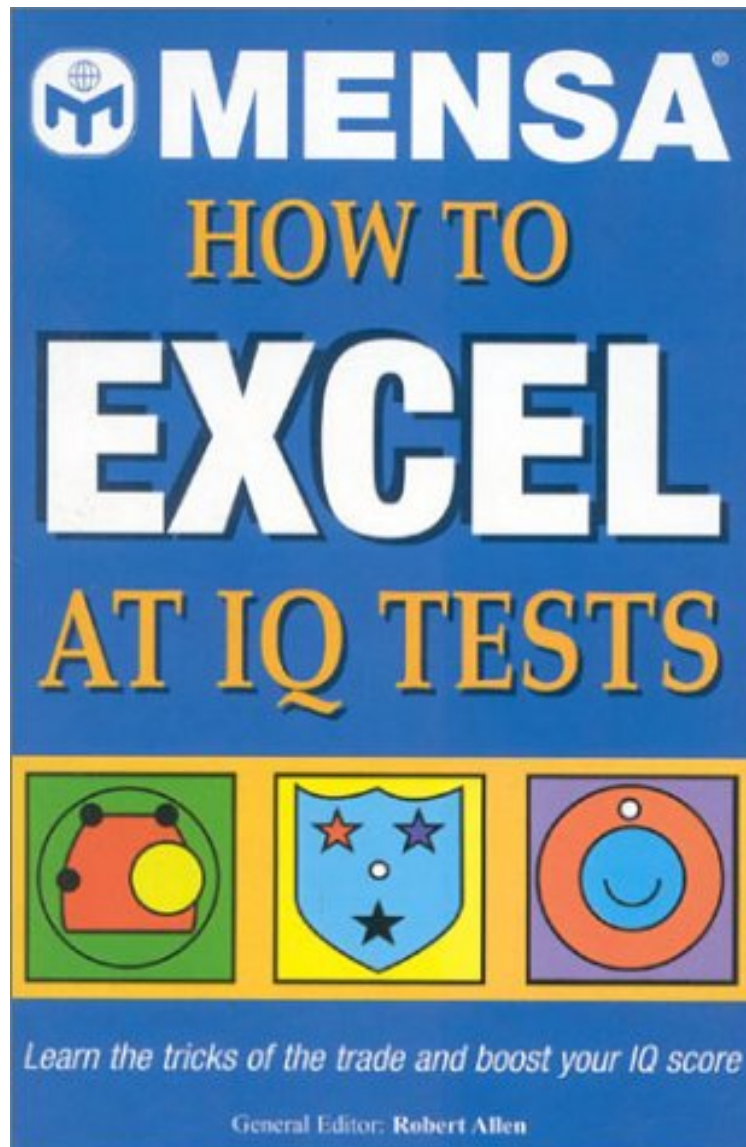

I specifically looked up this website to write this review and I was comforted by the fact someone else beat me to it. Other answers are just plain wrong. You would think, these people are obviously smarter than me, I must be wrong! But know the answers given in the back contradict the problems (can't work the problem backwards). I suggest someone at MENSA should attempt to work through potential books with their names on it before having the books published. The title is misleading, mostly the back is just an answer key, I rarely see more than a 2 word explanation of a problem. The book How To Excel At IQ Tests does not help you do anything of the sort. How are you to excel without explanation of answers or even tips?
