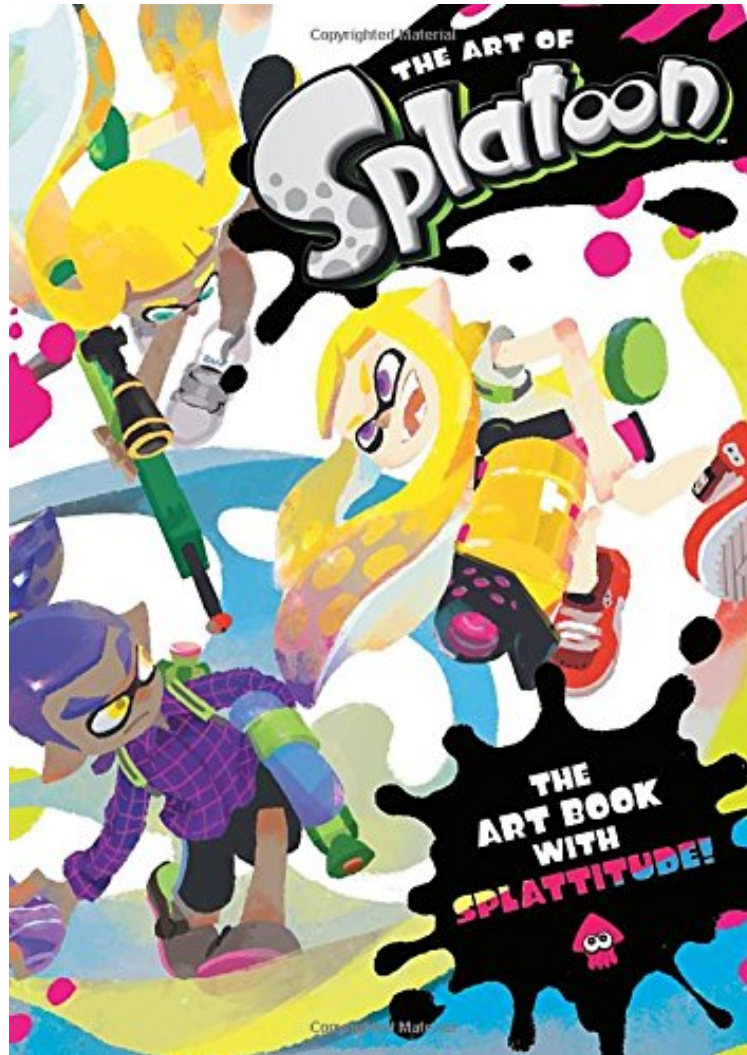

It also contains concept sketches and some comic strips there's a plethora of artwork, as you'd expect from a 330-page book. Nevertheless, I do have two complaints. I wish the book showed some of the development from before we had squids (i.e. the rabbits that predated them yes, the characters were almost rabbits!), and the weapon specs contained in this book are outdated. (This is

pointed out in the book preview, and these are the specs that appeared in the Japanese version.
