LanganThis book is lavishly decorated with photos and rare pics of memorabilia and features a nice tribute to the late John Lennon. That's the good part. The bad part is that with the exception of one interview of George Harrison and some quotes from the Fab Four, most of the interviews are from outsiders like a bouncer in the Cavern Club, Harry Nilson, Peter Brown (who wrote the trivial telltale The Love You Make), Mike McGear (Paul's brother), Julian Lennon (John's son), Neil Innes (who starred in the Rutles), and Mr. McKensie (who Geoffrey claims without a whole lot of proof was the inspiration to Fr. McKensie in "Eleanor Rigby"). In essence, what we learn from them is through hearsay (although some have some interesting stories to tell) and we really don't learn much of anything from Guliano about the Beatles that we don't already know. Also, some of the comments below the pictures have a lot to be desired: how are we to know that Geoffrey is telling us the truth about the pictures? If you're a collector, you might want this book (since it's currently out of print) but I can't recommend it to Beatles purists.0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
