ShinThis book is definitely not for a beginner, but this book never claims to be for beginners, so I'm not really sure why some people are displeas about that. This book was at the perfect level for my daughter who has been playing for about a year. She switched teachers about 6 months ago and the new teacher (like me) was not totally thrilled with the Hal Leonard book for kids. He was just teaching her from various sources, but eventually decided it was good to get a book. I don't like it when songs are dumbed down for the sake of teaching a

beginner. You can just select songs that are more appropriate for that level. We also didn't want a brand new beginners book for kids. My search led me to this book. The songs in this book are arranged wonderfully (daughter's teacher agreed). I tried it myself when it first arrived and was excited to see that not only was it at an appropriate level but that the songs vary in difficulty as well as the option of learning an enhanced version. I also like that the songs come in regular notation as well as tablature (for the music illiterate) and even includes fingering for the strumming hand. There is so much to learn. I can't wait for her to get started. The selection is also eclectic and includes songs from a wide range of the Beatles catalogue. I'm not sure why some buyers didn't think this was appropriate for children. You first start by teaching them the melody line! And about 16th notes--what a fun way to introduce music theory! Isn't that the way Suzuki teaches theory? It's through their songs. My child is only 6, and I am confident she can learn to play these pieces. I think it's an awesome way to also introduce the Beatles if your children are not familiar with them. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. So by Greekster I really wanted to like this book, but I felt that it had a couple of problems. First off, it doesn't have the lyrics, or more importantly, the lyrical line. The top melody line of some of the arrangements doesn't match the lyrics sometimes, so it can be hard to figure out which notes to emphasize. Also, some of the rhythms are written out in a way that I learned was incorrect like writing a 2 dotted quarters followed by a quarter instead of a dotted quarter followed by an eighth tied to a quarter followed by a quarter (it notes aren't broken properly given the tempo). This is something of a quibble but it's a problem when you've taught your students to read the rhythm the way it is normally (and I think it should) be written. Lastly, I think the arrangements are suitable for kids, though I would have liked to have seen at least a few songs with more pizzazz. These are mostly a simplified melody line with one bass note per bar. It's pretty sparse and can make high tempo songs sound very slow.
