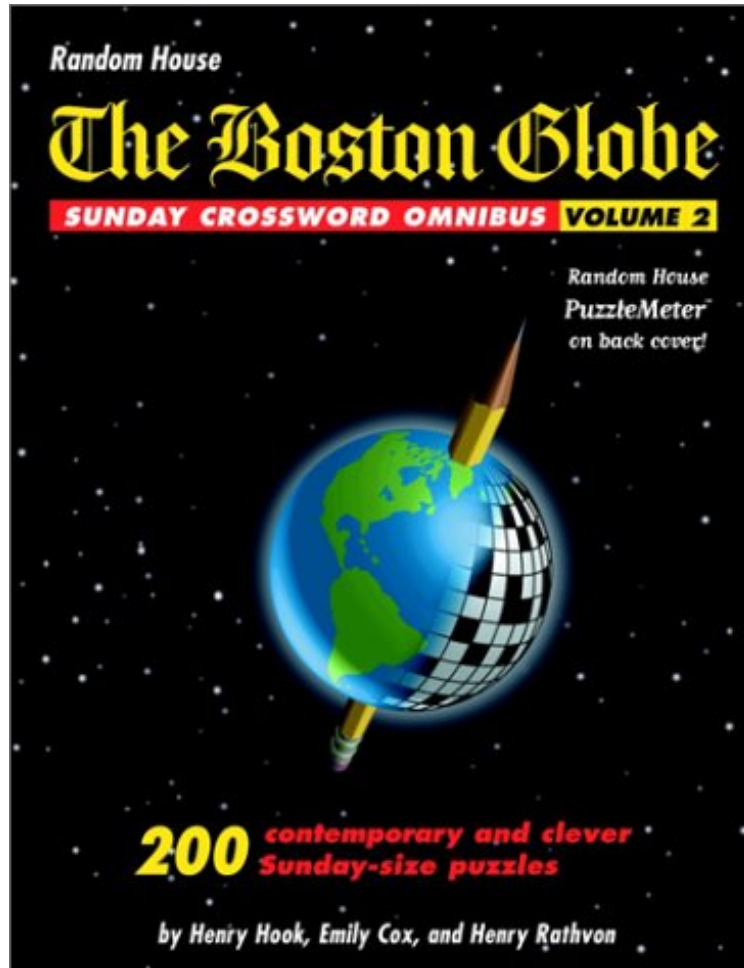

Update: After doing 20 pages of the Volume, the only repeats apparently were in the first 5 pages as stated above, so upping my review from the original two stars to three stars now.
